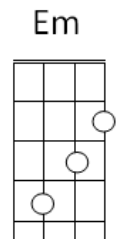
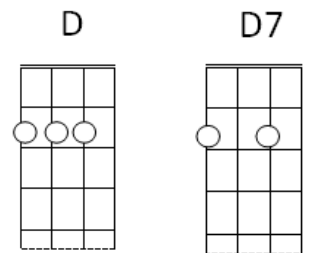
**Intro:** G D G /
